Job Description

Title: Math Specialist

Job Summary: The goal of the K-5 Mathematics Specialist is to work with students, teachers, the building principal, the K-5 Math Specialist Team and the K-5 Mathematics Department Head to actualize the district vision of excellence in mathematics teaching and learning for all students. A K-5 Mathematics Specialist works with teachers and students to improve mathematics teaching and student achievement.

Performance Responsibilities:

- Support and promote the learning of all students by facilitating adult learning through coaching, collaborative planning, and co-teaching.
- Develop excellence in teaching of mathematics so that it consistently and thoroughly reflects researched-based teaching practices for all students in all learning settings. Maintain a consistent and committed focus on access and equity in teaching and learning of mathematics.
- Support MTSS and instructional cycles by co-planning and co-teaching in classrooms. Coordinate data discussions and/or looking at student work sessions to promote data-driven decisions about teaching and learning of math. When needed provide direct instruction for individuals and/or small groups (Tier 3).
- Lead coaching cycles and/or lesson study for individuals/teams.
- Collaborate with the school principal/literacy specialist to facilitate school-based professional learning that supports district goals and is responsive to the needs of a specific school population and teaching staff.
- Support teacher and principal communication with families about the teaching and learning of mathematics.
- Serve on school-based leadership teams as requested by the principal.
- Collaborate with K-5 Math Specialist Team & K-5 Math Department Head on district wide curriculum and assessment initiatives.
- Plan for and facilitate district-wide professional development including unit preview and grade-level professional learning.

- 5 years successful elementary teaching experience highly preferred
- DESE certification in Elementary, Early Childhood and/or Mathematics
- Demonstrated commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion
- Demonstrated commitment to self-reflection and growth, able to model and nurture a culture of learning and curiosity about students' mathematical thinking and potential

- Ability to build professional relationships with teachers and inspire teacher trust and confidence.
- Strong mathematics content knowledge and mathematics pedagogical content knowledge
- Thorough knowledge of research-informed mathematics teaching and assessment practices
- Understanding of effective professional development and coaching strategies
- Ability to collect and analyze data in order to inform decisions about instruction and help teachers engage in using data in ways that impact instruction for all students
- Experience teaching mathematics using *Investigations in Number, Data, and Space* highly desirable
- Thorough and deep knowledge of the 2017 MA Mathematics Framework including the Standards for Mathematical Practice
- Self-motivated, organized, able to plan and follow through.
- Excellent communication skills
