Process for Completion:

Although the rental of music instruments by Wellesley Public Schools (WPS) is not subject to Massachusetts General Law (M.G.L.), Chapter 30B: Uniform Procurement Act. Wellesley conducts an annual survey of interested vendors of band and string instruments.

The survey provides the district information on:

- 1. Quality of instruments available to parents and students;
- 2. Pricing structures for rental and lease-to-own options;
- 3. Hours of operations;
- 4. Repair and maintenance processes; and
- 5. Loaned equipment.

Surveys are reviewed by the Director of Performing Arts. If necessary, site visits are made of potential vendor's business operations.

Recommendation of award is made by the Director of Performing Arts to the Assistant Superintendent for Business and Finance. Successful companies are notified in writing of the award.

Note: Parents are not restricted to the "approved" vendors. Only approved vendors will be invited to Wellesley's instrument rental night.
