School Enrollment and Reduction in Force	As a result of decreased enrollment there are a number of professional status teachers who will be displaced. The district will ensure that they are placed in schools where there are openings. This can affect Schofield teachers who are in years 1-3—Non-Professional category. Principals will work with human resources, teaching & learning, and the superintendent to finalized teaching assignments. We should also note that Taryn Arthurs, Grade 5 teacher, is coming back from her maternity leave in the fall.

Full time building teaching assistant (new position). Principals will work together to interview as a team. 4. Long term building substitute. Principals will work with human resources.
