<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be Fair Be a good sport! Same 4 square rules for everyone! • Be Inclusive Everyone can play! Look around and invite kids to play who are alone! • Be Kind Treat everyone like you want to be treated! Listen to friends! Use encouraging words, body language, and tone of voice! 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Negative facial expressions or rude gestures (eye rolling, sticking out tongue) • Put downs and other unkind words • Talking negatively behind someone's back • Threatening to leave someone out of a group or activity • Yelling • Whining, complaining, blaming • Talk or play involving pretend guns and other violent themes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name calling based on personal characteristics (gender, skin color, religion, body shape or size, intelligence, athletic ability, disability or what a person has or does not have) • Spitting, pushing, shoving, jabbing • Exclusion: stopping someone from having friends or from participating • Starting or spreading rumors (true or false) • Swearing at someone • Stealing • Three or more yellow level unexpected behaviors 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Punching, kicking or slapping • Threatening to hurt someone • Breaking or damaging property

<p>Student feels safe, comfortable, and happy.</p> <p>People around student feel safe, comfortable and happy.</p> <p>Opportunity for student to be an Upham Recess Leader</p>	<p>Discuss and encourage expected behavior. Use in the moment consequences and monitoring.</p> <p>Three or more yellow level unexpected behaviors = an orange level significant risk behavior.</p>	<p>First time offense use “in the moment consequence.”</p> <p>Second time offense classroom teacher calls parent.</p> <p>Third time offense, principal notified. Principal notifies parents. Red category consequence given.</p>	<p>k-2: Parent notified, reflection, miss one social time (lunch, snack, choice time). Restitution if possible.</p> <p>3-5: Parent notified, reflection, miss two social times.</p> <p>k-2: 2 social times 3-5: 4 social times</p> <p>k-2: 4 social times, individual behavior plan 3-5: 5 social times, individual behavior plan</p>
