It evokes themes of nostalgia and fantasization.

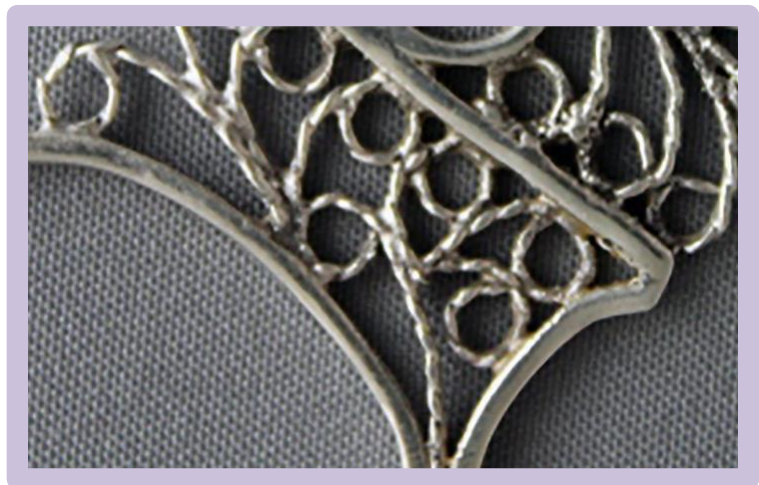
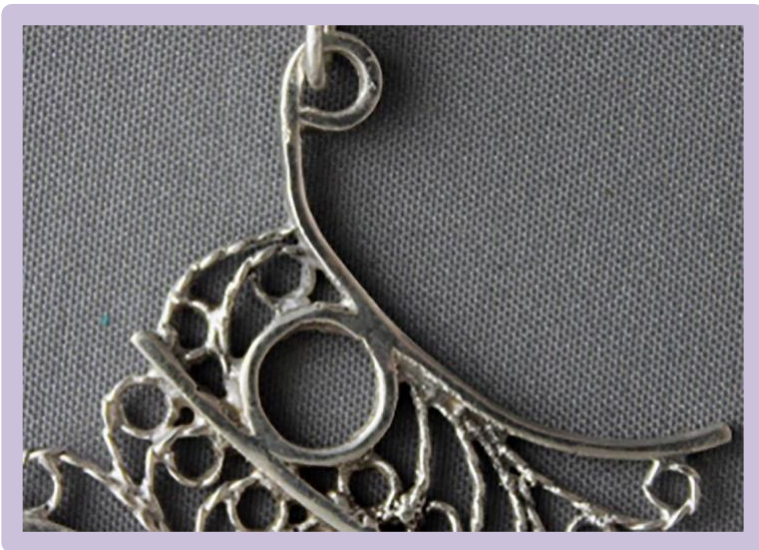






## baseball necklace

Best Friend Necklace Pair







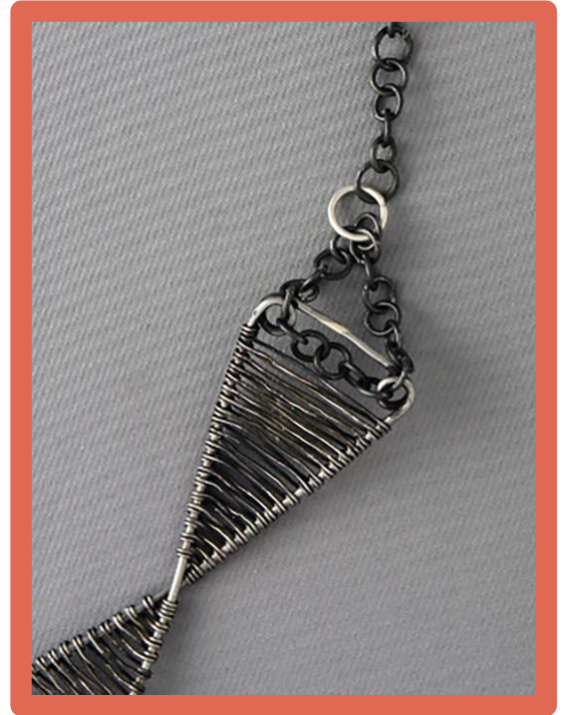
This pair of necklaces is inspired by Laufey's "Best Friend."

prolong the finite.



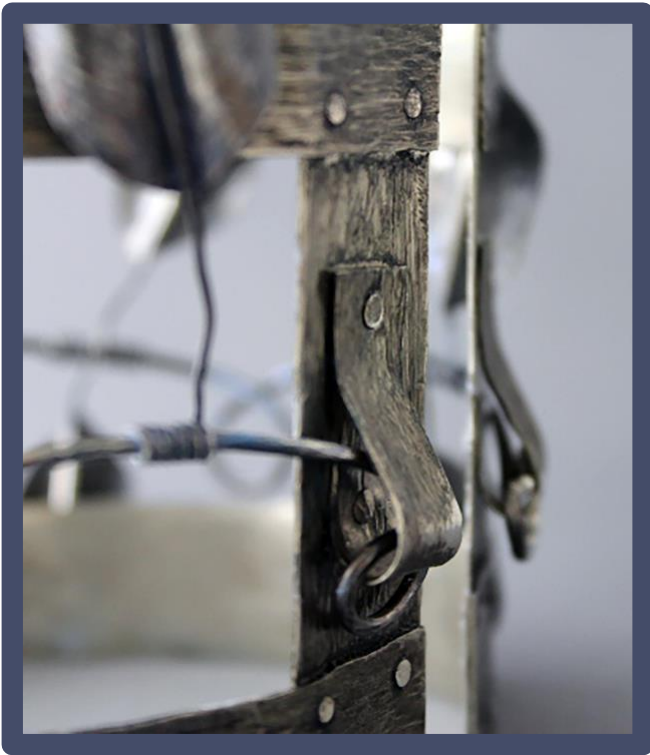




# Leave This City Arm Cuff

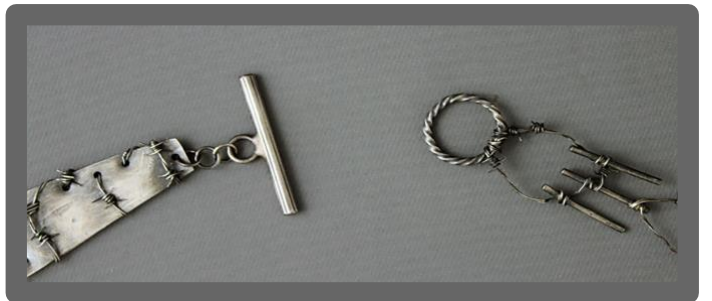






This piece is inspired by The Sundays' "Leave This City."
